I am the President and CEO of the Military Child Education Coalition (MCEC). I am writing to share my strong support for the Operation Military Experience (OpME) study, and to encourage young people and their families to participate.

The OpME study is led by Dr. Shelley MacDermid Wadsworth, who directs the Military Family Research Institute (MFRI) at Purdue University. MCEC has drawn on MFRI's expertise many times over the years, and we are very pleased that Dr. MacDermid Wadsworth accepted our invitation to serve on the MCEC Science Advisory Board.

MCEC is eager to learn about the downstream effects of OIF/OEF deployments for youth and families, and the OpME study will provide ground-breaking new information. MFRI's record of excellence and impact informs the PADDIE+M process that drives our planning, analysis, design, development, evaluation and maintenance of cutting-edge content for students, military parents, and the educators and other stakeholders who serve these students. MFRI's proposed research will further inform our efforts to make every military-connected student college-, work-, and life-ready.

If your family is invited to participate, I hope you will accept! The procedures for this study have been rigorously reviewed, so you can feel confident that only group information will be reported, no details about individuals.
